### **Future Research Talent Program 2027**

The Australian National University, Australia, invited the University of Delhi to the Future Research Talent Program 2024. The program is for Science students of their selected partner institutions and will provide them with an opportunity to travel to ANU in 2027 to pursue collaborative research projects. Each FRT scholar will receive AUD\$8,500 to support their travel to Canberra, Australia and cover living costs there.

There are 14 ANU Research Schools that have nominated over 90 research projects / areas/ groups that are open to hosting FRT scholars – students are to be selected that align with these research projects / areas.

Applications were invited from all the Departments of the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Mathematical Science, Faculty of Inter-disciplinary & Applied Sciences, Faculty of Technology and Cluster Innovation Centre of the University of Delhi.
